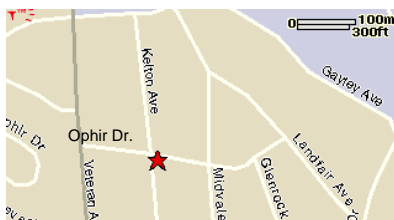
An evening of conversation with Professor Wilfred M. McClay

Professor Wilfred M. McClay received his doctorate degree in history at Johns Hopkins University. He is currently a Sun Trust Bank Chair of Excellence in Humanities and Professor of History at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. His research interest is on the intellectual and cultural history of the United States, with particular attention to the social and political thought of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries; the theory and practice of intellectual biography, and the history of religious thought and institutions.
