Teresa La Porte is a professor of International Communication at the University of Navarra (Spain) and Visiting Professor of Intercultural Communication of the Communication Politique et Publique of the Universite Paris XII-Val de Marne (France). She is currently a visiting professor at the School of International Relations at USC, teaching on European Union Public Diplomacy. Prof. La Porte has also been distinguished with a Fulbright Grant. Most of her research is related to the analysis of international political news in the media and public diplomacy strategies. Currently her work is focused on the public diplomacy of non-state actors. She has participated as academic specialist in the project “A New Public Diplomacy for Spain” held by the Spanish think tank Real Instituto Elcano.
